INSTRUCTIONS TO REGISTRANT	
<p>The operation of a POV on a military installation is a privilege extended by the Installation Commander subject to compliance with appropriate State laws pertaining to financial responsibility, safety inspections and registration; to conditions established in paragraph 3-2, chapter 3, AR 190-5-17; and other appropriate regulations. Failure to comply with such laws and regulations may result in an administrative suspension or revocation of driving privileges or termination of installation registration. The registrant must remove the registration decal from the registered vehicle upon PCS, termination of employment, or sale of POV.</p> <p>"I am aware that AR 190-5-17 and Fort Monroe Reg. 190-5 provide for the removal and temporary impoundment of privately owned motor vehicles that are either parked illegally for unreasonable periods, interfering with military operations, creating a safety hazard, disabled by accident, left unattended in a restricted or control area, or abandoned. I agree to reimburse the United States for the cost of towing and storage should my motor vehicle(s), because of such circumstances, be removed and impounded."</p>
